- Inspect for New & Outstanding Violations
- ❖ Send "Friendly Reminder" Notice
- ❖ Send "2nd Maintenance Reminder" Notice
- Send "Legal Notice"...Which May Result in Referral to Attorney!
- Work with City of Fort Worth Code Enforcement Officers
- Work with Neighborhood Police Officers



Property Modification Requests & ACC Process?

- Why Is It Necessary?
- "When In Doubt...Fill It Out!"
- Include All Information to Expedite the Process.
- Decision Within 15 Days.
- ACC Approvals Good for 6 Months




