What Happens if I Don't Pay My Assessments?

The assessments for Park Glen Neighborhood Association are \$66 due in October of every year. If the assessment is not paid, a collection procedure for pursuing delinquent accounts is started. For each month an assessment remains unpaid, a \$15 collection charge is added to the delinquent owner's account along with interest. Unpaid accounts are subject to reporting to the credit bureau and filing an affidavit of lien against the property. Any owner who is unable to pay the assessment when due is encouraged to contact the property management company at (817) 337-1221 to make payment arrangements.






