Pumpkin Pancakes

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 cups milk
- 1 cup pumpkin puree
- 1 egg
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 2 tablespoons vinegar
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 3 tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon ground allspice
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Directions

1. In a bowl, mix together the milk, pumpkin, egg, oil and vinegar. Combine the flour, brown sugar, baking powder, baking soda, allspice, cinnamon, ginger and salt in a separate bowl. Stir into the pumpkin mixture just enough to combine.

2. Heat a lightly oiled griddle or frying pan over medium high heat. Pour or scoop the batter onto the griddle, using approximately 1/4 cup for each pancake. Brown on both sides and serve hot.

Most external modifications, repairs, and enhancements to your property require the approval of the Architectural Control Committee. But this month, let's talk about how you can avoid submitting a property modification request on two common projects.

Satellite Dishes

The installation of a satellite dish generally requires the submission of a property modification request and the approval of the ACC. But a request is not required for a typically-sized satellite dish if placed on the back of the home, not visible from the street. This elimination of the 15-day approval process is especially helpful for homeowners because satellite dish companies are often able to install dishes in just a matter of days after your order. But how can you get your installer to place the dish on the back of your home when they prefer the side or even the front? Satellite dish installers typically want to place satellite dishes on the side of the home because that is easiest for them, but they are usually willing to

do the small amount of extra work to place the dish on the back of the home if they know that it is a neighborhood standard and is important to you. So just offer them a cold drink and ask them to put it on the back. Without too much trouble, they can probably run a wire through the attic or around the home to the necessary point of entry, leaving the dish out of sight and benefitting both you and the neighborhood.

Fences

Property modification requests are required for fence work that will result in any of the following:

- any part over 6' in height,
- any non-wood part (other than gate hardware) visible from any street
- any change in fence line
- any unusual or possibly nonconforming style or appearance
- any color pre-applied or to be applied or reapplied
- a metal fence, or
- the replacement or modification of fences on

lots that have ever had metal fences

But repair of a fence can be done without a property modification request if there is no change in the material type, height, style, or position of the fence and also no application or reapplication of color (other than black on a previously black iron fence). And you can bypass a property modification request when you replace a wooden fence with a traditional and conforming wooden fence that will not exceed 6' in height and have no non-wood part (other than gate hardware) visible from any street, with no change from existing fence line, and no color pre-applied or to be applied or reapplied. As always, fence poles, regardless of their material, must not be visible from any street.

Even if your satellite dish addition or fence repair/replacement does not require a property modification request, the finished product must still comply with the neighborhood's Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CCR's or Deed Restrictions) and Bulletins and maintain the harmony and conformity of the neighborhood. If there is any doubt, please submit a request for ACC approval.




