The primary factor will be overall presentation ("wow factor"), but judges will also consider uniqueness & creativity, storyline or theme, and neatness & organization. 2016 and 2017 winners and properties with past due balances owed to the Association or outstanding deed restriction violations will not be eligible.

13 homes will be selected (one from each of Park Glen's 13 villages), with each winner receiving a \$50 gift card and a yard sign to display for the remainder of the month. Winners will also be announced and pictured on our website and in the January newsletter. Be creative, be festive, and have fun!

In her home, the pull-down attic ladder was attached with sheet rock nails instead of the proper attachments. It detached and fell down with her husband several years ago. He had surgery, a metal plate, screws, and 6 weeks of therapy to regain the use of his arm.

More recently the mantel fell off the fireplace. Thank God nobody was injured. The mantel had no support and was just a stack of bricks held on by caulk.

This resident contacted her original builder but has so far not gotten restitution or a resolution. She encourages you to check out your mantel and attic stairs to make sure you don't have the same problems.

COVENANT CORNER





Many new and even longtime Park Glen residents don't know or understand what the ACC does and why we need it. Here is a brief explanation to provide some understanding.

Every homeowner and property in Park Glen is bound by a set of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions (CCR's). These CCR's are in place to help create harmony and uniformity throughout the Park Glen community. Without it, our area could look like any other neighborhood in Fort Worth. It is easy to see that our CCR's add value to your home.

ACC Approval is required prior to making most exterior improvements to your property, including fencing, additions, storage sheds, changes to landscaping, roofing, and paint. To begin the process, first find the Property Modification Request form on this page of our website: http://parkglen.org/property-modification-acc.html.

Before filling out the form, please read the following, which many people don't do:

- the CCR's for your part of Park Glen (http://parkglen.org/deed-restrictions-ccr-s.html)
- the community-wide Bulletins (http://parkglen.org/deed-restrictions-ccr-s.html)
- the Property Modification Form and instructions

Then please fill out the form completely and submit will all needed information. If it's incomplete, it will just be sent back for more details. Most projects require drawings, plans, and/or pictures in addition to dimensions, descriptions, and colors.

The ACC will consider every request to determine if the project complies with Park Glen's deed restrictions and is in harmony with the other neighborhood properties and in conformity with community standards. The request will be APPROVED, APPROVED with Conditions/Stipulations, DENIED needing Clarification/More Information, or DENIED. Park Glen's Community Management Company will handle communication between homeowners and the ACC.

Any denial will be accompanied by the reason for denial and if possible, how to correct the request so it can be approved. If your request is APPROVED or APPROVED with Conditions, you may begin work. You have 6 months from the approval date to complete the work.

The ACC is here to protect our most valuable assets – our homes! Our goal is not to tell you "no, you can't do that," but rather to help you make your home more valuable and attractive in a neighborhood that is among the most popular of all of Fort Worth.

The committee is made up of Park Glen homeowners. If you have some free time and share the committee's goals, please consider joining our group! We are always looking for people to be involved with the ACC process.



PARK GLEN SCOUTING


