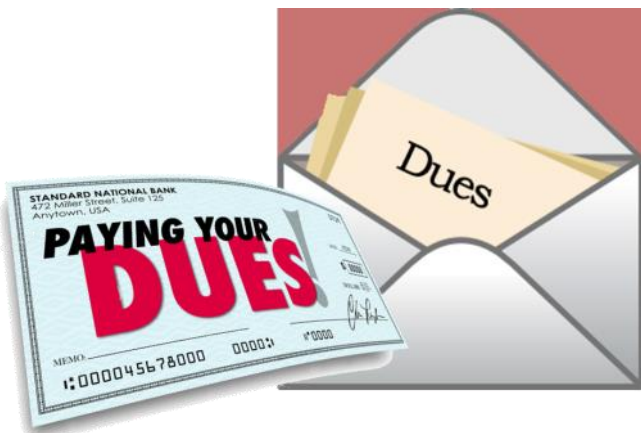

COVENANT CORNER

Satellite Dishes: do you have an unused satellite dish on your house, visible from the street (from a service you no longer have)? Please remove it and make your property more attractive.

Basketball goals may not be kept in or near the street.

Above ground pools are not allowed in Park Glen, even if not visible to anyone outside of your yard.

Window air conditioning or ventilation units are not allowed.

Tree stumps must be ground down below grass level or removed.

Tree wells without a tree must be removed or have a tree planted in them.

Scholarship Program

The Park Glen Board of Directors recently received and considered an anonymous letter about the Association's Scholarship Program, so we are taking this opportunity to respond.

The letter implied that the Scholarship Selection Committee may show favoritism based on applicants' names. But the Scholarship Coordinator redacts all identifying information from all documents provided to the Selection Committee. Applications are evaluated and selected without the Committee knowing the names of the applicants.

There was also a suggestion that Board members and their dependents should not be allowed to apply for scholarships. But it hardly seems necessary or fair that Board members who give up time and livelihood to serve their fellow residents and provide programs like this should also have to give up the impartial opportunity to earn scholarships that all other homeowners have.

Finally, it was suggested that the program should be changed to provide an easier path for earning scholarships to students more advanced in life, family, and/or career. The Board expressed no support for different selection criteria for different types of students.

What a fun month for the Scouts in Park Glen. The Scouts are right in the

middle of their “Popcorn Sales”. They have been selling popcorn at several retailers and door to door. Thanks for supporting Scouting. Popcorn sales support local units and provide quality programs for the boys.
